Membership Drive: The early renewal discount is \$145 for payments by March 1, 2026 announced previously; initial responses positive. Recruitment from rifle/pistol range continues.

RSO schedule for Outfitters and Members

7-11 shooters = need the instructor plus 1 RSO/Instructor

12-16 shooters = need the instructor plus 2 RSO/Instructors

17-21 shooters = need the instructor plus 3 RSO/Instructors

22+ will need the instructor plus 4 RSO/Instructors

Traps available for Outfitters: Unless explicitly arranged, Outfitters are to use the Upper and Lower traps and the skeet traps.
